



Need help with your course fees?

If you are aged 19 and over and want to study a further education course at level 3 or above, you may qualify for an Advanced Learner Loan. It's easy to apply for and you will not have to make any repayments until you've completed your course and your income is over £25,725 a year. Student Finance England will pay your course fees directly to the college once we have confirmed your attendance on your chosen course.

This quick guide gives you some key facts about applying for an Advanced Learner Loan. The graphic on the back takes you through the step by step application process.

Top Tips for Applying

1. Have the following to hand when making your application:
 - Your Learning and Funding Information Letter (see step 3 on the reverse of this leaflet) showing your course and college details
 - Your National Insurance Number
 - Your valid UK passport details (if you have one)
2. Complete and submit your application as soon as possible to ensure your loan is in place for the start of your course
3. Apply online – it's easy and your application will be processed quickly. You should hear within two weeks from applying
