

## **Remote Learning 2021/22**

City College Commitment Statement City College Southampton is fully committed to delivering a full and engaging curriculum offer throughout 2021/22 that has been designed to meet the needs and interests of its communities.

However it is possible that during this academic year students and apprentices' opportunities for on-site learning might be disrupted. The College recognises that the disruption, may be to individuals or classes or to the whole college community.

In order to ensure that students and apprentices continue to make progress to achieve their qualification and progress to their next step City College Southampton commits to:

- Contacting individual students if they are self-isolating to plan their study with them. Their teacher will identify where they can find work on Citybit and to confirm what activities are to be completed that day including both their main programme and English and maths where appropriate.
- If a class has to learn online delivering a full programme of on-line timetabled activity.
- Directing students to on-line activities when their teacher is ill and no cover is available. These students will be registered at the beginning of each timetabled day via a Zoom tutorial.
- Delivering a full programme of on-line timetabled activity in the event of the College being advised to stop face-to-face teaching and to amend, assessment plans and methods as appropriate.

The College understands that remote learning depends on all students and apprentices having sufficient access to a computer and the internet. A survey of student and apprentice home access will be completed during September 2021.

A laptop loan scheme is in place for young people and some adult students who report through the survey that they have insufficient access to computer equipment to study online.

Where a student is not able to access a computer and/or the internet, work will be sent home for them to complete and returned for marking when they are back at the College.
