Wear suitable footwear and clothing

If you have applied for one of the following courses, please make sure you bring suitable clothes and shoes with you:

Construction Crafts (Brickwork, Carpentry, Electrical Installation, Painting and Decorating and Plumbing) Engineering, Marine and Motor Vehicle:

- Safety or strong shoes with a flat sole and closed-toe should be worn
- No sandals, flip-flops or heeled shoes will be allowed in workshop areas
- Your clothes may get dirty. Please don't wear anything that cannot be cleaned easily

Hairdressing and Beauty Therapy

As you will be working in the college salons during Welcome Day we ask that you please follow our normal dress code:

- Smart, plain (ideally black) clothes (trousers, shirt)
- No jeans, leggings or trainers
- Enclosed black shoes (i.e. with toes covered)

Hospitality and Catering

- Shoes with a flat sole and closed-toe should be worn
- No sandals, flip-flops or heeled shoes will be allowed in kitchen areas
- Your clothes may get dirty. Please don't wear anything that cannot be cleaned easily
